

Summer School Consciousness and Cognition - Scholarships Regulation 2025

University of Pisa offers 2 scholarships and Unione Buddista Italiana (UBI) offer 6 scholarships.

Scholarships are reserved to students enrolled in a Bachelor or in a Master Degree course in 2024.

The scholarship covers only the cost of the tuition fee. The winners, if they participate in presence, will have to independently provide for travel and accommodation expenses.

5 Scholarships will be destined to students coming from low GDP countries* depending on CV;

3 scholarships will be destined on the basis of the following items:

- 1) Highest qualification obtained so far (Bachelor's, Master's, Research Doctorate);
- 2) Score achieved in the academic qualification or weighted average of the exams passed;
- 3) Curriculum Vitae;
- 4) Motivations;

Students interested in applying for a scholarship, only after completing the registration and receiving the admission letter, are requested to send an email, with the word "Scholarship" as a subject, directly to the Director of the SS, Prof. Bruno Neri (bruno.neri@unipi.it) with an attachment of maximum one page containing the following information:

- 1) name and surname,
- 2) nationality;
- 3) the highest education degree (Bachelor, Master degree, PhD) obtained and the final rating (please attach the certificate); applicants currently enrolled in a bachelor program could apply but must indicate the year of enrollment and the medium rating on the examinations up to now;
- 4) current occupation if different from student; for this purpose, all those who were enrolled in a bachelor's or master's degree program as of 12/31/2024 will be considered students.
- 5) a short CV (mandatory less than 200 words);
- 6) motivation letter to attend the Summer School "Consciousness and Cognition", (mandatory less than 100 words).

Scholarship applications submitted by those who have not previously been regularly admitted will not be considered.

Deadline for application is May 24th 2025 at 1pm. The list of scholarship recipients will be published by May 31th 2025.
