
FREE MOVER PROGRAMME

The Free Mover programme is meant for international students who are not already participating in an exchange programme such as the Erasmus programme. Students choose a host university and then organise their own study period overseas independently

Who can apply?

In order to participate the student must have a foreign citizenship and fall under one of the following categories:

- have obtained a High School diploma overseas;
- be enrolled in a degree programme at a foreign university;
- have obtained a degree from a foreign university.



You can attend:

I SEMESTER (first or second semester)
you can take a maximum of 30 credits
fees: 416.00 euros (to pay once in Italy)

II SEMESTERS (entire academic year)
you can take a maximum of 60 credits
fees: 716.00 euros (to pay once in Italy)

Why applying?

With the Free Mover programme, you have the opportunity to have an experience abroad and study in one of the most ancient and prestigious universities in Italy; you can study new and different disciplines, choosing from almost the entire academic offer; you can experience the life in Pisa and the academic world without applying for a full time degree programme. Once you have ended the Free Mover programme you can decide when to enroll and credits you have got will be recognized.

How does the academic year work?

The academic year is divided into **2 semesters**:

- 1 Semester: September – January
- 2 Semester: February – July

There are different **exam sessions** through the year:

- 1 Session: January – February
- 2 Session: June – July
- 3 Session: September

What is the CFU?

Each course/activity has a number of Crediti Formativi Universitari (CFU) assigned, which indicate the amount of work meant as frontal lessons and individual study that a student must do to complete the activity.

1 CFU = 1 ECTS

The academic year corresponds to 60 CFU/ECTS



I AM AWARE THAT I MUST BE IN POSSESSION OF THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS AT THE MOMENT OF ENROLMENT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF PISA:

- photocopy of the passport or of the ID card;
- copy of the Residency Permit or copy of the Post Office receipt which declares the student has already applied for the Residency Permit (it is best to also bring the original Residency Permit or the original post office receipt). Please note this only applies to **non-EU citizens**;
- receipt of having paid the university fee of 400 euros if enrolling in one semester or of 700 euros if enrolling for the whole academic year;
- one of the following documents (in Italian or in English depending on the type of document available):

for high school graduates -diploma certificate issued on the school's letterhead stationery and translated into English or Italian;

for undergraduate students-certificate of enrolment at a foreign university, issued on letterhead stationery accompanied by a presentation letter written in English;

for university graduates-degree certificate issued on the university's letterhead stationery accompanied by a presentation letter written in English.

You will receive an **acceptance letter** which you must take to the Italian diplomatic authorities in the country of residence in order to request a study visa (if you are a non-EU student).

After being accepted, remember you have to register on the online portal of the University called **Alice**. You can do it before leaving or once in Pisa.

Registration for admission exams, evaluation tests and enrolment
In order to register to an admission test, to a degree course with limited places, to an evaluation test or to enroll, you have to access your reserved area and select the option of interest from the menu. All information (deadlines and procedures) are published on the [Matricolandosi portal](#). If you graduated in a Bachelor's or Master's degree, you can print off your Diploma Supplement at any time and free of charge.

New user registration

The following pages will allow you to register as a new user of the portal. When you do so, make sure to have an I.D. and tax code (codice fiscale) readily available; you will need to type in some personal details and phone numbers. Once you have registered, you will be given a users name and you will need to create a password in order to have access to some areas of the portal. You will then be able to:

- Sign up to public selection procedures (concorsi) and evaluation tests;
- Choose a Degree programme with open access (enrollment);
- Do the online registration if you are an international student (ERASMUS, Free Mover, Summer school, other exchange programmes).

ATTENTION: access to the University of Pisa's wireless network will only be possible once you have enrolled in a Degree programme.

Once in Pisa

- ➡ Apply for the [residency permit](#) within 8 days from your arrival in Italy (if you are a non-EU student).
- ➡ Write an email to international@unipi.it (only after the registration on the Alice Portal) so that the office will create the invoice with the amount of fees to pay.
- ➡ You can visualize your fees on the Alice Portal. You can pay the fees online or print the invoice and pay it in any bank.

The day of the appointment, please, bring with you:


- Identity document and a photocopy
- Visa (if you are a non-EU student)
- Residency Permit or the Post Office receipt of the application, and a photocopy (if you are a non-EU student)
- Payment receipt
- Acceptance letter
- one of the following documents (in Italian or in English):
 - diploma certificate (for High School graduates);
 - certificate of enrolment at a foreign university (for undergraduate students);
 - degree certificate (for university graduates).
